

Professor Jörg Hartung, President of the ISAH, has been appointed Doctor honoris causa in Agronomy at the Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences (SLU).



On the 9th of October 2010, the Faculty of Landscape Planning, Horticulture and Agricultural Sciences at SLU in Alnarp appointed Jörg Hartung, professor at the Univ. of Veterinary Medicine in Hanover, as Doctor honoris causa. “He has performed research regarding climatic and environmental effects of animal husbandry. His work has contributed to improved welfare in animal transports, and he has also studied how environmental pollutions are affecting the health och animals and humans.”

The Honorary lecture by Professor Jörg Hartung had the title: *Bio-aerosols in Farm Animal Houses, Risks for Animal, Man and Environment*.
