PREFACE

As for the history of the International Society for Animal Hygiene the Congress the first time it took place in Poland. It is also important since Poland has joined to the United Europe some problems connected with animal hygiene in UE during the Congress are undertaken.

The XIIth Congress of ISAH is held in Warsaw, September 4-8th 2005 in the Campus of the Agricultural University. The leading topic of this Congress is "Animals and Environment". More than 150 scientists from over 50 countries present theirs papers.

The scientific part of the Congress divides into three plenary sessions: herd-health management as a tool for improving health and production of livestock; environmental protection and public health in respect to animal hygiene; animal welfare as an integral part of sustainable animal production.

In parallel sessions authors will present (in oral and poster presentations) the current state of science and practice in the following fields: health and environment in cattle, pigs, poultry production; welfare and behaviour of animals; waste management; disinfection; food safety and veterinary public health and other subjects connected with animal hygiene.

We direct our thanks to the invited speakers, to all contributors with oral and poster presentations, and to the scientific and organizing Committees whose enthusiasm has made the organization of this Congress possible.
